#### Transportation to Ruhr University Bochum (RUB)

The closest and most convenient airport for reaching RUB is Düsseldorf Airport (Düsseldorf Flughafen). It offers more connections and shorter travel times compared to KölnBonn Airport. Both airports have direct train connections to Bochum Hauptbahnhof (Hbf, main train station).

- •Düsseldorf Airport: Travel time to Bochum Hbf is approximately 40 minutes.
- •Cologne-Bonn Airport: Travel time to Bochum Hbf is approximately 1 hour 30 minutes.

Please note that travel times can vary depending on the type of train you choose:

- •S: Slower trains with more stops.
- •R: Regional trains with fewer stops.
- •ICE, IC, EC: Faster trains, but often more expensive and not recommended for this short trip.

Due to potential delays and changes in the Deutsche Bahn (DB) train schedule, it is advisable to purchase your train ticket upon arrival at the airport. There are ticket machines in the train stations and they accept both cash and credit cards.

•Train frequency: Approximately every 30 minutes.

## Long-distance and air travellers

At Bochum's main train station, ICE, IC, EC, regional trains and city trains arrive and depart in quick succession.

Ticket: Currently, it exits the "Deutschland-Ticket." This ticket only costs 49 EUR per month and allows for unlimited travel around most of the trains and public transportations (bus, tram, metro) in the country. The main exception is ICE, IC, and EC; fast trains are not included.

- Public transportation in Germany is very expensive, we suggest to purchase this ticket since the beginning of the trip in Germany.



No matter whether you are coming from the south, north, east or west – many roads lead to the campus of Ruhr-Universität Bochum.


#### How to get here

You'd like to get to Ruhr-Universität Bochum in an environmentally friendly and sustainable way? No problem, the university is very easy to reach by public transport, bike or on foot; parking spots, however, tend to be difficult to find.


#### By public transport

From Bochum's main railway station (Bochum Hbf), you can take the underground U35 (CampusLinie) to get to Ruhr-Universität Bochum, which has its own stop. The U35 (going in the direction of Bochum Hustadt) runs every 5 minutes on weekdays and takes less than 10 minutes from the main station to the university.

### How to get to WorldFactory Start-up Center

#### How to get here

The WorldFactory is not located in the campus but in a new and modern location. To reach the Center, there are two possibilities:

- 1. To take the public transportation (bus)
- 2. To walk through parks and residential area

#### By public transport

The most convenient is the **Bus 372**. From Bochum Hallenbad Querenburg stop to O-Werk stop, it takes about **15 minutes**. Important note: there is only <u>one bus per hour</u>. Departure time is at 1:04 pm.

Another Bus is <u>number 358</u>. Bochum Hallenbad Querenburg stop to O-Werk stop, it takes about <u>37 minutes</u>. Important note: there is only <u>one bus per hour</u>. Departure time is at 1:15 pm.

#### By foot

Alternatively, there is the option of a nice walk to the Center through nature and residential area. The time is about 45 minutes.
